Whereas; the Board of Education of the Enlarged City School District of Middletown has adopted a resolution and policy related to the regulation of traffic and parking of District property, a copy of which is attached to this resolution, and

Whereas, pursuant to the resolution the Board of Education has requested that the City of Middletown assist the District in enforcing the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Education with respect to stopping, standing and/or parking and other related traffic matters involving District property located in the City of Middletown, and

Whereas, pursuant to Section 1640-a of the New York Vehicle & Traffic Law, the City is empowered to enforce such restrictions of property owned and designated by the District, and

Whereas, the City is willing to assist the District in that endeavor.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Middletown that Section Chapter 460, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of the City of Middletown is amended to add Section 460-9A, Regulation and Control of School Parking Lots, to read as follows:

Section 460-9A. Regulation and Control of School Parking Lots.

No motorcycle, motor vehicle or any other vehicle of any type shall stand, be left Standing stop, park or be operated contrary to any rules, regulations and/or signage approved and/or adopted and/or installed from time to time by the Board of Education of the Enlarged City School District of Middletown with respect to roadways, lanes or parking areas on District property located at and used at the Middletown High School, the Presidential Park Elementary School; the Truman Moon Elementary School and/or the Twin Towers Middle School.

Be it further resolved that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
