

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received by the City of Middletown, New York, until 4:30 p.m. (local time) on March 26, 2020 for the "*Green Infrastructure Improvements*." Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 4:30 PM on March 26, 2020 at the office of the Mayor, City of Middletown, 16 James Street, Middletown, New York.

The work consists of storm water retrofits at the James Street parking lot, the Orchard Street vacant lot, the Hanford Street parking lot, the City Hall/First Federal Savings Bank parking lot, the Union Street parking lot and Erie Way Park in the City of Middletown. Information for Bidders, Drawings, Specifications, and Contract Documents for the proposed work is on file and publicly exhibited at City Hall, 16 James Street, Middletown, New York, Telephone Number (845) 346-3169. The said drawings and specifications may be reviewed at the City of Middletown's Public Works Department office only.

Copies of the bid package and plans are available on CD or as paper copies, and may be obtained at the office of the DPW Commissioner, at the above address, during normal business hours. Persons shall leave name, mailing address, email, phone number and fax number upon receipt of same, along with a \$100.00 deposit for each set. The deposit shall be in the form of check or money order made payable to the City of Middletown, to be refunded to unsuccessful bidders upon return of the said documents in good condition within ten days after receipt of bids.

There will be a pre-bid meeting at 1:00 PM, Wednesday, March 11, 2020 at City Hall/Common Council Chambers, that all interested bidders are encouraged to attend.

Each bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders and must be accompanied by an acceptable form of Bid Guarantee in an amount equal to at least five (5) percent of the amount of the bid payable to the City of Middletown as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute the Contract and file acceptable Performance and Labor, Material Payment Bonds, and Certificate (s) of Insurance in a timely manner after the award of the Contract.

Bids shall be enclosed in a sealed opaque envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, addressed to the City of Middletown, 16 James Street, Middletown, NY 10940, and endorsed "*Green Infrastructure Improvements*."
