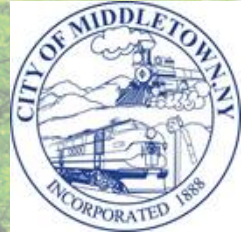


# Keep Our City Green, Clean and Beautiful



City of Middletown is proud to introduce a new automated waste pick-up program. This change will impact properties in the City that are currently picked up by the DPW Sanitation Department.

This program will be implemented in two phases:

- a. Phase I starts on April 12, 2021- Deployment of City provided carts
  - i. Single Family Dwelling: One 95 Gallon MSW and One 95 Gallon Recycling Carts
  - ii. Two Family & Multiple Family Dwelling: Two 95 Gallon MSW and Two 95 Gallon Recycling Carts
- b. Phase II: Deployment of new Sanitation Truck with mechanical arm.

The above is being provided at no charge. The carts will each have a serial number and will be assigned to a specific address and will remain property of DPW and can only be used for MSW or Recyclable purposes.

To receive additional carts, up to a maximum of 8 (4 MSW and 4 Recycling) per SBL, please contact us. There will be an annual charge of \$100 per additional cart requested.

MSW (Household garbage) and recyclable can only be placed inside the City carts. Additional garbage bags or cans outside City provided carts will not be picked up and will constitute a violation of City code, subject to fine and appearance in court.

This program is being implemented to keep our City clean, protect our workers and save money.

Only you buying into this effort, as a responsible member of our community, will make this program a success.

Please place the cart(s) within 4 feet from the edge of your driveway. Properties without a driveway should contact DPW for coordination and refer to City Code 407.
